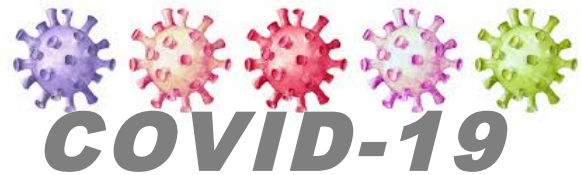
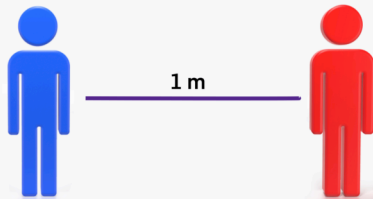

If someone came with you today, consider asking them to wait outside the clinic, if possible

OB Patients

OB consultation and follow-up appointments will continue

Postpartum appointments will be re-booked, where possible

If coming, please leave your newborn at home

GYN Patients

Urgent and essential GYN consultation and follow-up appointments will continue

For seniors and patients with serious chronic medical conditions, every effort will be made to put you in an exam room ASAP

Non-urgent appointments will be re-booked, where possible, especially for seniors

Phone follow-up appointments will be booked, where possible

Our Medical Office Assistants (MOAs) may be working from home on non-clinic days. On those days, you will need to e-mail or leave a voicemail message, and they will get back to you.
